<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Our literacy text for spring term are: Room on a broom Old toy Room Colour monster</p> <p>Children will talk about the characters, the problem in the story, will explore feeling and emotions through freeze frames and they will join in with repeated refrain or rhymes. New vocabulary from the texts will also be introduced.</p> <p>Children will use their phonic skills to write lists, letters, potions, and to describe.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>In maths we will continue to count and explore numbers and number bonds. We will also identify the patterns around us. For example: stripes on clothes, designs on rugs and wallpaper. Use informal language like 'pointy', 'spotty', 'blobs', etc . Extend and create ABAB patterns - stick, leaf, stick, leaf. Notice and correct an error in a repeating pattern</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic- Understanding the world</u></p> <p>This half term our role play will be a police station. Where children will be able to take on the role of a police officer! We will be looking at the different people who help us.</p> <p>Look at different occupations and Talk about members of their immediate family and community.</p> <p><u>Computing- Exploring technology</u> Children will be using ipads to scan QR codes to find games and information.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE</u></p> <p>We will be looking at Special Places in religion. This will include a visit to our local church.
